### **Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Report to: Foreperson
- Work on a team to install both large and small scale landscape projects, including but not limited to: soil prep, grading, planting, sodding, pruning, annual and bulb planting, stonework and green roof installation.
- Prepare to start work on time: 6:45am – 5pm daily. Attendance and punctuality are essential. Able to work extended hours (including some Saturdays) as required during peak periods. Our season is generally late March to December inclusive.
- Daily tasks to be performed with safety in mind at all times.
- Train to improve your work performance to meet the quality standards of LPGC.
- Ongoing commitment to develop skills to become a CHT.
- Work full days outdoors in all weather conditions.
