As a supervisor and worker of a 2 or 3-person crew, cooperating with your crew-mates, you will monitor materials used and record daily paperwork in a professional manner and on a routine schedule. You will display initiative to work towards ongoing education and training to improve your Horticultural knowledge and pursue the goal to achieve status as a Certified Horticulture Technician (CHT) while maintaining the standards of our LPGC Employee Guidelines.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Report to: Horticultural Service Representative/Manager
- Practice, respect and enforce the Field Employee Guidelines.
- Work Monday to Friday 6:45am – 5pm daily. Able to work extended hours (including some Saturdays) as required during busy periods. Our season is generally late March to November inclusive.
- Organize your day with jobs & equipment required.
- Train to improve your work performance to meet the quality standards of LPGC.
- Daily tasks to be performed with safety in mind at all times for yourself & your crew.
- Ongoing commitment to develop skills to become a CHT.
- Ensure that crew paperwork is completed properly for submission to the office.
- Attend meetings as scheduled (or last minute).
- Miscellaneous additional duties as assigned.
